

K. APPLICANTS WITH EXCESSIVE NEEDS

In the event that an applicant has water or sewer requirements that exceed the Authority's ability to supply from the existing system without adversely affecting service to other customers, the Authority will not be obligated to give such service unless and until suitable self-liquidating financing is arranged to cover necessary investment in expanding the plant.

For example, if a customer needs more water than the present system can produce without cutting back service to customers who are already on the system, the Authority can refuse to serve that customer until the Authority can borrow the money to upgrade their plant to handle the increased need. The money borrowed must be repaid by the user fees generated by the system improvements, that is, the new industrial customer's fees.
