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## ROCKBRIDGE COUNTY NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Notice is hereby given per Section 15.2-2204 and 15.2-4307 of the Code of Virginia and Section 802.03 and 610.00 of the County of Rockbridge Land Development Regulations that a joint public hearing will be held by the Rockbridge County Farm and Forest Preservation Committee and the Planning Commission on Wednesday, September 9, 2009, at or around 7:00 p.m. at the Courtroom in the County Administrative Offices, 150 South Main Street, Lexington, Virginia 24450, followed by a public hearing by the Board of Supervisors on Monday, September 28, 2009 at the same time and location to consider the special exception application by the Maury Service Authority, POB 922, Lexington, Virginia. The application is to install a water transmission line in the Agricultural and General Uses District (A-2), Agricultural Transition District (A-T) and the General Business District (B-1) per Sections 603.03-9, 603B.03-14 and 605.03-10 and 610.05 respectively in order to assure a reliable source of potable water for the community.
