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## ROCKBRIDGE COUNTY NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Notice is hereby given per Section 15.2-2204 of the Code of Virginia and Section 802.03 of the County of Rockbridge Land Development Regulations that public hearings will be held by the Rockbridge County Planning Commission on Wednesday, October 14, 2009, at or around 7:00 p.m. at the Courtroom in the County Administrative Offices, 150 South Main Street, Lexington, Virginia 24450, followed by a public hearing by the Board of Supervisors on Monday, October 26, 2009, at the same time and location to consider the following applications for special exception permits.

1. Wisdom Foundation, 449 Galloping Path, Natural Bridge, Virginia, has applied to change the conditions of their permit to operate a meditation center in the Agricultural and General Uses District (A-2) per Section 603.03-15 of the Regulations. Property is located off of the north side of Broad Creek Church Road approximately .8 miles west of its intersection with South Lee Highway in the Buffalo Magisterial District and further identified as Tax Maps 96-A-31A.
2. Rockbridge County PSA, 150 South Main Street, Lexington, Virginia, applying for a permit to locate a water pumping station in the General Business District (B-1) per Section 605.03-10 of the Regulations. Property belonging to John Farrar is located at 1037 Long Hollow Road approximately .3 miles south of its intersection with Jordan Road in the South River Magisterial District and further identified as Tax Map 77-13-4.
3. Marlbrook Chapel, 4973 Forge Road, Glasgow, Virginia, has applied for a permit to place a third dwelling on the same parcel in the Agricultural and General Uses District (A-2) per Section 702.01-3 of the Regulations. Property belonging to John Malone is located at the above address along the south side of Forge Road at its intersection with Stoner Hollow Road in the Natural Bridge Magisterial District and further identified as Tax Map 107-6-2B.
