ROCKBRIDGE COUNTY NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given per Section 15.2-2204 of the Code of Virginia and Section 802.03, 04 and 05 of the County of Rockbridge Land Development Regulations that public hearings will be held by the Rockbridge County Planning Commission on Wednesday, July 14, 2010, at or around 7:00 p.m. at the Courtroom in the County Administrative Offices, 150 South Main Street, Lexington, Virginia 24450, followed by a public hearings by the Board of Supervisors on Monday, July 26, 2010, at the same time and location to consider the following applications:

1. Central Dispatch Center, 806 Park Avenue, Buena Vista, Virginia, applying for a special exception permit to place a 60 foot tall radio communications tower in the Agricultural Transitional District (A-T) per Section 603B.03-16 of the Regulations. Property owned by the Rockbridge County Public Services Authority is located off of the south side of Buck Hill Road approximately .2 miles east of its intersection with South Lee Highway and is further identified as Tax Map 106-14-1F in the Natural Bridge Magisterial District.
2. Don Jeffer, 200 Black Bridge Lane, Natural Bridge Station, Virginia, applying for a special exception permit to construct a grass landing strip in the Agricultural and General Uses District (A-2) per Section 603.03-4 of the Regulations. Property is located along the west side of Arnolds Valley Road across from its intersection with James River Road and is further identified as Tax Map 113-7-1 in the Natural Bridge Magisterial District.
3. Rockbridge County, 150 S. Main Street, Lexington, Virginia, applying to amend the Land Development Regulations to allow propane storage and distribution station 500 gallons or less as a permitted use in the General Business District (B-1). Stations greater than 500 gallons will continue to be a use by special exception per Section 605.03-17 of the Regulations.
