
The Board reviewed questions Richard Hasey had from his recent training.

Whitney Huffman informed the Board that there was an upcoming training provided by the Republican Party of Virginia that she would attend the report back to the Board.


The Board adjourned to Executive Session to conduct the annual review of the General Registrar at 11:35 am.


The Board resumed regular session at 12:45 pm with no other business discussed other than personnel. The Board reviewed the registrar's annual review with Sheila Hall.

Meeting adjourned at 1:00 pm.





