1. Natural Bridge Hotel and Conference Center, 15 Appledore Lane, Natural Bridge, Virginia, applying for a special exception permit to construct a biomass co-generator to support the energy needs of the Hotel in the General Business District (B-1) and the Agricultural and General Uses District (A-2) per Sections 605.03-10 and 603.03-9 of the Land Development Regulations. Property is located along the west side of South Lee Highway at the intersection of Wert Faulkner Highway in the Natural Bridge Magisterial District and further identified as Tax Map 106-50-33.
2. Lynn and John Sherrard, 1308 Thornhill Road, Lexington, Virginia applying to rezone 74 acres from Residential General (R-1) to Agricultural and General Uses District (A-2) for agricultural purposes. Property is located behind The Summit and adjacent to Meadowview Subdivisions and accessed off of Thornhill Road in the Buffalo Magisterial District and further identified as Tax Maps 74-A-56, 56B and 56F.
