ROCKBRIDGE COUNTY NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Notice is hereby given per Section 15.2-2204 of the Code of Virginia and Section 802.03, 04 and 05 of the County of Rockbridge Land Development Regulations that public hearings will be held by the Rockbridge County Planning Commission on Wednesday, November 9, 2011, at or around 7:00 p.m. at the Courtroom in the County Administrative Offices, 150 South Main Street, Lexington, Virginia 24450, followed by public hearings by the Board of Supervisors on Monday, November 28, 2011, at the same time and location to consider the following applications:

1. Charles W. Barger & Son and Medusa Properties, Inc., POB 778, Lexington, Virginia, applying to rezone three acres from General Industrial (I-1) to General Business (B-1) so the current land uses conform with zoning per Section 605 of the Regulations. Properties are located along the south side of East Midland Trail at the intersection with Long Johns Lane and are occupied by Long John Silvers, Bed Rock Car Wash and a residential rental in the Buffalo Magisterial District and are further identified as Tax Maps 75-14-1 and 2 and a portion of 75-A-40.
2. Forest Dhamma Monastery Organization, applying for a special exception permit to locate a retreat in the Agricultural and General Uses District (A-2) per Section 603.03-15 of the Regulations. Property owned by StillForest, LLC, 7740 N. Lee Hwy, Raphine, Virginia, is located along the south side of Snakefoot Lane approximately one mile west of its intersection with Springbranch Road in the Buffalo Magisterial District and further identified as Tax Map 93-A-8.
