ROCKBRIDGE COUNTY NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Notice is hereby given per Section 15.2-2204 of the Code of Virginia and Section 802.03, 04 and 05 of the County of Rockbridge Land Development Regulations that public hearings will be held by the Rockbridge County Planning Commission on Wednesday, July 11, 2012, at or around 7:00 p.m. at the Courtroom in the County Administrative Offices, 150 South Main Street, Lexington, Virginia 24450, followed by public hearings by the Board of Supervisors on Monday, July 23, 2012, at 6:00 p.m. at the same location to consider the following applications:

1. Adam's Construction Company, POB 12627, Roanoke, Virginia, applying to change the conditions of an existing special exception permit to operate an asphalt plant in the General Residential District (R-1) to eliminate the conditions that regulate time of day operations. Current conditions are inhibiting the ability to comply with contract conditions. Property is located along the east side of Flower Lane just past its intersection with Quarry Lane in the Buffalo Magisterial District and further identified as Tax Map 75-A-55, 57 and 58.
2. Boxerwood Education Center, 963 Ross Road, Lexington, Virginia, applying for a special exception permit to expand some of the activities at a grandfathered private school in the Residential General District (R-1) per Section 604.03-4 of the Land Development Regulations. Property is located along the south side of Ross Road approximately .5 miles west of the Lexington City limits in the Buffalo Magisterial District and further identified as Tax Maps 74B-A-20/20A, 74B-2-B/C/F and 74B-3-1.
