## ROCKBRIDGE COUNTY NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Notice is hereby given per Section 15.2-2204 of the Code of Virginia and Section 802.03, 04 and 05 of the County of Rockbridge Land Development Regulations that public hearings will be held by the Rockbridge County Planning Commission on Wednesday, October 11, 2017, at or around 7:00 p.m. in the Meeting Room in the County Administrative Offices, 150 South Main Street, Lexington, Virginia 24450, followed by public hearings by the Board of Supervisors on Monday, October 23, 2017, at 6:00 p.m. at the same location to consider the following applications:

Dominion Energy, 701 East Cary Street, Richmond, Virginia, applying for a special exception permit to expand a substation in the Agricultural and General Uses (A-2) per Section 603.03-9 of the Land Development Regulations and modify the exterior fence design. The previously applied for expansion was not implemented and footprint has changed. Property is located off of the east side of Turkey Hill Road approximately .35 miles north of Lindsay Lane in the Kerrs Creek Magisterial District and further identified as Tax Map 48-A-59.

Rockbridge County, 150 S. Main Street, Lexington, Virginia, amending Section 707 of the Land Development Regulations to treat on-site manufactured construction office trailers as a permitted use in the General Business District (B-1) and the General Industrial District (I-1) for the life of the construction project instead of as a use by Special Exception.
